

Key Combinations for the new Windows Indigenous Keyboard (For physical UK keyboard)

Acute Accent (using the ' (apostrophe) as a dead key): áéíóúýáéíóúý

Grave Accent (using the ` (grave accent) as a dead key): àèìòù`àèìòù`

Tilde (using the ~ (shift-#) as a dead key): ãẽĩõũỹÃẼĨÕŨỸ

Circumflex Accent (using the ^ (Shift-6) as a dead key): âêîôûÿÂÊÎÔÛŸ ěšĚŠ

Umlaut (using the : (Shift-;) as a dead key): äëïöüÿÄËÏÖŮŸ

In addition to the above combinations, you can also use AltGr to obtain the following characters:

AltGr + c = ç

AltGr + C = Ç

AltGr + i = ï

AltGr + I = Ĩ

AltGr + g = ġ

AltGr + G = Ġ

Finally, you can add combining accents as well as an underline with the following key combinations:

AltGr + ' = acute

AltGr + ` = grave

AltGr + ~ = tilde

AltGr + ^ = circumflex

AltGr + : = umlaut

AltGr + - (hyphen) = underline

Note that the combining accents are typed after the base character. Generally, this is used for letters that do not have pre-determined combinations as those listed above, or to create combining accents.

To avoid conflicts with barred characters, the AltGr + vowel combinations do not give accented characters, as they do with normal UK keyboards. Other than this, the keyboard functions as a normal UK keyboard.
